Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility.

This week, CMS announced plans to begin reopening nursing facilities, which includes offering limited forms of visitation.

Our Facility has followed federal, state and local guidelines throughout this pandemic in an effort to keep our residents and employees safe and reduce the spread of COVID-19, and we will continue to do so.

We are currently reviewing our visitation policy, and our clinical leadership teams are working on creating visitation plans and procedures that will allow families and friends to visit with their loved ones while complying with all federal, state and local requirements for visitation and infection prevention and control.

We're organizing and planning as quickly as we can to allow for safe visitation as soon as possible. We will be reaching out to all of our families once an official visitation procedure is in place. Until such time, we will follow our current visitation policy. We recognize how much families have missed their loved ones. We have missed you, too.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
